Collecting Information

This information includes, but is not limited to, your name, address(es), social security number, birth date, telephone number(s), e-mail address(es), driver's license number, marital status, number of dependents, beneficiary information, employment status, annual income, investment objectives, investment experience, and investment risk tolerance.

Sharing Information

Farley Financial does not provide, share, communicate, or redistribute any portion of your personal or financial information in any form without your written consent to any party other than those listed below:

- Your investment custodian
- Mutual fund or insurance companies whose investments or policies you own
- State and federal investment regulators
- Law enforcement, or as required by court order

Protecting Information

Access to clients' personal information is limited to Farley Financial representatives who need to know that information to service clients' accounts and help them accomplish their financial objectives. Farley Financial representatives are required to maintain and protect the confidentiality of all personal information. To comply with applicable laws and regulations, Farley Financial maintains physical and electronic safeguards to protect this information.
